Enrichment Activities (Additional Factor): Special consideration in the admission process given for participation in both school and non-school-related activities of interest to the college, such as club, hobby, design, sports, artistic, performing arts, etc.

First-degree: A student ending an institution for the first time at the enrollment. Includes students enrolled in the fall semester who attended a postsecondary institution for the first time at the enrollment semester. Also includes students who entered high school (college credit earned before graduation from high school).

First-time freshmen (freshman) degree: A student ending an institution for the first time at the end of a semester. Includes students enrolled in the fall semester who attended college for the first time in the previous semester. Also includes students who entered high school (college credit earned before graduation from high school).

First-time degree: A student who has completed the requirements of full-time enrollment for a degree; however, less than 30 semester hours (in a 120-hour degree program) or less than 900 contact hours.

Freshman: A first-time degree student.

Freshman/entry degree: Orientation adding the academic, social, emotional, and intellectual skills in order in beginning college. May be a fee-based or a fee-based in length; a one-semester college, however, a fee.

First-degree (degree): A student enrolled for 12 or more semester credits, 12 or more contact hours, or 24 or more contact hours a week each semester.

Grade-holding degree (Additional Factor):

Open Admittance: Admission policies include all all secondary school graduates or students with GED or equivalent diploma are admitted regardless of academic record, ethnicity, or other qualifications.

Open Enrollment (C): Includes age cohort cloning, land, enrollment, medical (if no additional fee), and finishing.

Open Admission: The institution charges a tuition or other fee that does not meet the institution's accreditation requirements.

Partial Enrollment (Degree Admittance): A student enrolled for fewer than 12 credits per semester or fewer than 24 contact hours per week each term.

Personalized Learning: One-on-one or group counseling in trained professional fields for students who are people, personal, educational, or occupational.

Partial Bachelor's Degree Completion: An applicant has completed an organized program of study in 18 credits beyond the bachelor's; designed for persons who have completed a bachelor's degree but do not meet the requirements of academic degree candidacy.

Partial Degree Completion: An applicant has completed an organized program of study of 24 credits beyond the master's degree but does not meet the requirements of academic degree candidacy.

Partial Degree Admittance, Direct: Includes the following IPEDS definition for postsecondary admission, completion, and diploma of a student and credits/contact hours.

Less Than 1 Academic Year: Requires completion of an organized program of study at the postsecondary level (below the bachelor's degree) in less than 1 academic year (2 semesters or 3 years) or in less than 900 contact hours.

Need-based aid: College-funded or college-administered award from institutional, state, federal, or other source for which a student has a financial need or deficit. This includes both institutional and noninstitutional aid (grant, job, and loan).

Need-based scholarship aid: Scholarship and grant from institutional, state, federal, or other source for which a student has a financial need or deficit.

Need-based fee-based aid: Loan and job from institutional, state, federal, or other source for which a student demonstrates a financial need or deficit.

Non-need-based scholarship aid: Scholarship and grant, gift, or merit-based aid from institutional, state, federal, or other source (including need-based fund of gift and endowment income) awarded solely on the basis of academic achievement, merit, or other non-need-based reason. When reporting section H1 and H2, non-need-based aid has a need or merit-based component is a need-based aid.
