



Our last event of the semester was a sur chill study session whe DOO RI XV ate some Mediterranea food and talked abou how the semester we and how we were going



Hello, my name is Kiera Puls and I am the current Local Section Meeting/Plant Tour Coordinator.


My job is to promote the attendance of students to the Chicago local section monthly meetings and organize tours to operating plants and chemical engineer-
